





I believe that is why Abraham went to Beersheba nd lived there. I believe Abraham sent Isaac back to Sarah. Sarah probably didn't trust Abraham close to her son after that. Mothers get a little sensitive about anyone planning to end the lives of their children.

Since Isaac was 37 years old, it's probably safe to guess he was off on some business trip.
